WTO is please to introduce our new catalog for the Okuma machines. This new catalog includes the Genos, LB EX Series, and new LT- EX series “M” function machines.

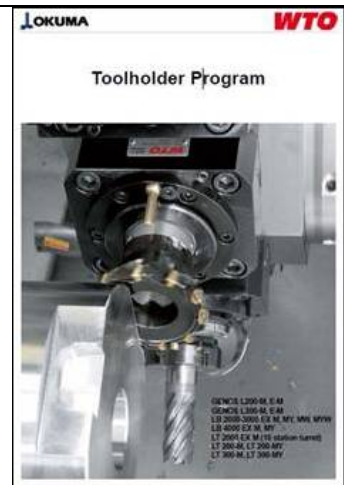
